External User Authentication BC-AUTH-JAAS



Definition

- The SAP Web Application Server Java offers a pluggable authentication framework, which is based on JAAS standards (Java Authentication and Authorization Service).
- Allows arbitrary login modules to be plugged in and to be combined with login module stacks.
- Vendors can provide additional login modules for additional authentication mechanisms.

Scope

- This certification verifies a 3rd party JAAS login module and fulfills the requirements for a proper functionality in SAP Web Application Server Java.

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Security Assertion Markup Language BC-AUTH-SAML



Definition

- The SAP J2EE Engine supports the use of Security Assertion Markup Language (SAML) for Single Sign-On.
- SAML is a XML-based markup language, that is being developed and standardized by the Organization for the Advancement of Structured Information (OASIS).
- It is used for exchanging security-related information between communication partners.
- The SAP J2EE Engine supports SAML in a scenario where a user is authenticated to an external authentication system that acts as an SAML authority.

Scope

- Based on this authentication, the user can access the desired resource, in this case, an application on the SAP J2EE Engine.

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Directory Interface for User Management via LDAP

BC-LDAP-USR



Definition

- SAP's directory interface lets you consolidate user data from SAP systems with data from directories that implement the Lightweight Directory Access Protocol (LDAP).
- Using a directory service (including the SAP Central User Administration), you can maintain the data from a single point of contact.
- At most companies, user data is stored in the directories associated with various software systems and components, such as e-mail, telephony systems, operating systems, and other data-dependent applications.
- By using the directory interface for user management via LDAP, you can consolidate this data in a single, central directory often called the Meta Directory.
- This consolidation enables you to eliminate redundancy and ensure data consistency across multiple applications, while offering all of the advantages of a single point of administration.

Scope

- Using the LDAP directory interface to connect to an LDAP directory server.

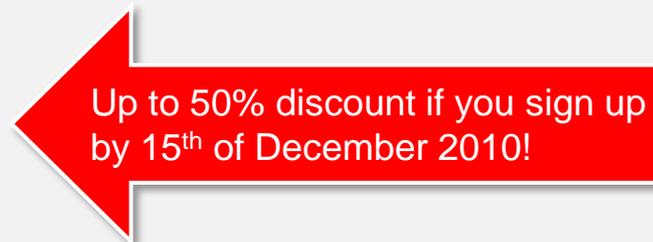

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Network Security

BC-SNC



Definition

- BC-SNC protects data that is exchanged between distributed SAP NetWeaver components and an integrated external security system, and enables the use of cryptography and smart cards to authenticate users.
- An SAP NetWeaver system administrator can adjust the level of protection by setting SAP NetWeaver profile parameters for BC-SNC.
- When we refer to SNC, we are referring to a software layer that SAP has implemented within all relevant SAP NetWeaver components to achieve the protection goals described above.
- As the programming interface between the SNC layer and external security products we use the standardized *Generic Security Services Application Programming Interface (GSS-API) Version 2 [1;2]*. This standard has been developed by the "Common Authentication Technologies" (CAT) working group of the Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF)

Scope

- The external security system can provide strong authentication, data integrity, and data confidentiality services to the SAP communication layer.

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Secure Store & Forward and Digital Signatures

BC-SSF



Definition

- Secure Store & Forward (SSF) provides functions that SAP NetWeaver applications can implement in order to protect sensitive data.
- This is particularly useful if data is transferred across insecure networks or is stored on external media.
- Digital signatures and encryption ensure the integrity of the data, the authenticity of the sender, nonrepudiation, and confidentiality.

Scope

- SSF mechanisms use an external security system to protect SAP data. The external system is linked using a SAP NetWeaver interface defined by SAP in the SSF Application Programming Interface (API).

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SAP NetWeaver Identity Management Connector NW-IDM-CON



Definition

- The purpose of the Connector Development Kit (CDK) is to enable the independent software vendors (ISVs) or SAP partners to create an Identity Management connector for their application, and to integrate the application in the Identity Management landscape.
- The provisioning framework in the Identity Center is the core of the provisioning, and will call the basic tasks to perform the operations in the target systems, i.e. the framework populates the Identity Center with a set of basic tasks for performing provisioning.

Scope

- Create an Identity Management Connector to connect to the vendor security product.

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SAP Virus Scan Interface NW-VSI



Definition

- The SAP NetWeaver Virus Scan Interface (NW-VSI) allows external anti-virus and content security solutions to integrate with SAP Web AS (ABAP/JAVA).
- This Virus Scan Adapter is built by the anti-virus solution provider based on SAP templates in the Software Development Kit (SDK) for Virus Scan Adapters.
- This standardized process provides a transparent job division between SAP data to be scanned (SAP know-how) and the actual virus scan (Anti Virus know-how).
- Additionally, it also allows SAP customers to easily switch between anti-virus and content security solutions based on their business needs.

Scope

- Build an Virus Scan Adapter which connects a virus scanner to the SAP system.
